## **SITE INFORMATION**

**Girton Sailing Club** is the location for the 2019 AGM on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> April. A very friendly sailing club who have offered the use of their Clubhouse for our AGM and evening social. A full programme of social events will be included over the long weekend including a bring and share supper on Saturday evening and on the Sunday the Boating Group heat for the Club's Eat Local Cookery Competition. If you can cook a simple meal on a BBQ or gas burner then why not enter and you could win a fantastic prize of a CADAC BBQ. It is all friendly and light hearted so why not put your name forward to enter.

Girton Sailing Club is a small club with an interesting lake formed from old gravel workings, with islands and coves, formerly known as Hoveringham Sailing Club. There is about 100 acres of water in total beside the river Trent about half way between Newark on Trent and Gainsborough. It is a beautiful, tranquil spot. There is a sizeable clubhouse with a galley, bar, hot showers, wet area and soft furnished club room area.

There are a number of electric hook ups and a grassy area for camping and caravanning overlooking the lake. (These will be available on a first come first served basis) Good slipways and a beach area for launching boats which can be left beside the water which makes getting them on the water easy. Canoes are also welcome.

The club have a range of dinghies for hire, so if you do not want to bring a boat then you can hire one on site. There is also a small fleet of access boats and the club is part of the Sailability Scheme, so if you have a disability or just do not feel able to sail an ordinary dinghy you could take to the water in one of these specially adapted boats.

These are nature reserves, interesting walks and good cycling routes all around with other places of interest within easy reach.

In addition to the AGM weekend the Boating Group are invited to join in with the Sailing Club's Raft Race weekend over the August Bank Holiday. Maybe the Boating Group could enter as a team or just enjoy the fun. There will be plenty of sailing opportunities and social events during the weekend. Camping will be limited to 10 units so do not leave it too long to book.
